Meeting called to order at 5:32 pm by Asheli Polychrones (PTO President)

Pledge of Allegiance led by Jessica Brown (PTO Vice President)

Present August and September Meeting Minutes- Kathryn Pendleton (PTO Secretary)- motioned for approval of meeting minutes by Kathryn Pendleton, with a second by Asheli Polychrones.

Treasurer's Report by Jessica Meade (PTO Treasurer)- September financial report is added at the end of this agenda. Boosterthon brought in our goal of \$35,000. We were able to pay the school their \$15,000 for the school wide project and pay all grade levels 10% of their Boosterthon earnings.

Spirit night at Panda Express brought in \$182.60.

Fall Picture Day- Tomorrow! Thank you to those who are volunteering.

Outdoor Movie Night- We managed to get enough volunteers for this event, so thank you very much! It is important to note that you cannot just drop your Gator off. Kids need to be accompanied by an adult. There will be sidewalk volunteers and bathroom monitors to make sure things run smoothly.

Trunk-or-Treat details- Stephanie Damiani- Carnival games (ring toss, beanbag toss etc.) will be set up in the field and the lights will be on during the event. Kids can also play on the playground. On the blacktop, there will be a monster mash section with music, dancing and glow sticks. In the back parking lot is where the cars will be that have volunteered to display a trunk. In the front loop of the school there will be five food vendors- Taco Tuesday, Lunchbox on Wheels, Good Puff, Three Sisters Baking, Dolce Rico Bakery. The fire department has graciously offered to provide a firetruck for the evening for display. We are waiting to hear back from a few more vendors, including Code Ninjas. We will be selling tickets for this event at the Outdoor movie night on Friday, and also at our spirit night at Five Guys on October 18. The bulk of our volunteers are coming from the National Honors Societies at Mountain View and Colonial Forge high schools. There are a few jobs that need to be adults, so please look to volunteer for a thirty minute time slot. We tried to take the burden off families for volunteering so we are grateful for the high schoolers that will be there to volunteer. Susan from Fletcher Homes will be doing face painting for the kids. We would like one more face painter, so if you know of someone that could do this, please let Stephanie or Asheli know.

After School Enrichment- placements will be emailed October 13th, and the Fall session will begin on October 18th. We have had a tremendous amount of sign ups! If you are still looking to sign up,

please include your student's name with the payment. Ms. Leonard will be the point of contact if you have any questions.

Holiday Festival- We are looking for vendors and donations for the silent auction, and grade level donations. We are looking for a few more committee chairs. Jenna Cooper has been the chair for the last few years, but this is her last year having a Gator at the school, so we'd like a few others to step up. Kirsten Lewis sent a message in the chat that she would be willing to help with the Holiday Festival. We are looking for help with the Elf Cafe, Elf shop, helpers for the photo wall, and the silent auction. We have quite a few people already helping, but could use more. Ms. Golles brought up that the book fair will be going on during the Holiday Festival and would love any interested volunteers.
