Membership

- Membership drive has ended, but you can join at any point in the year.
 - Dues are \$10 per family and \$5 for staff members

 - We try to keep the website up-to-date as much as possible so that it's a good source of information for families and staff

Boosterthon

- Over halfway through fundraiser this is our only big fundraiser for the entire school year
 - Last check we are close to reaching \$19,000 of our \$25,000 goal
 - Ms. Jacque's class is currently in the lead but it's a close race!
 - 67% of our students are registered we'd love to get that number higher
 - Students are working their way up their classroom team pledge o meter to earn fun little extras – like silly sock day, extra recess and pieing the principal
 - Students are learning about a different character trait each day with Gator Joe and Bayou Brandon
 - Gratitude, Stewardship, Bravery, Perserverance, Wonder and Resolution
 - You're able to watch all of the videos about the daily character trait on mybooster.com

Fun Run

- 3 runs this year because of increase in student numbers and keeping the track safe while running
- Kinder/1st 10am, 2nd/3rd 11am, 4th/5th color run at noon
 - Anyone is welcome to join us and cheer on our gators as they run
 - Check in at the gate near the playground with your ID and get a visitor's sticker – you do not need to come to the office
 - If you are joining for the 10am run, please do not enter the parking lot until after 9:30
 - AG Wright dropoff will be happening and we don't want to impeded their traffic flow and process
- Shirts
 - All students will get a special Gator shirt to wear that day courtesy of PTO and Debbie Stump
 - Laps will be marked on the back as the students complete them
- Bad Weather Plan glow runs would happen inside and we wouldn't be able to have spectators
 - Will communicate that if needed

Gator Gear

- 126 orders slightly up from last October
- Expect all product in-hand in a couple of weeks and will do classroom distribution once it arrives and is sorted
- Question from parent: Will Gator Store open again this year?
 - IF it opens again, it won't be until Jan/Feb
 - We do not have orders open year-round because it is not cost efficient

- We would need to charge a significant amount more on spirit wear if we did it this way because printers charge us more for small quantities
- Having 1 large, bulk order keeps all of our costs down and makes the spirit wear more affordable for everyone

Looking Ahead/Volunteer Needs

- ASE (After School Enrichment)
 - Fall/Spring after-school program with activities
 - Classes can be offered in any subject area depending on volunteers preference
 - We've had everything from STEM, rugby, crafts, yoga, etc
 - Parents, staff and community members may teach classes must be fingerprinted by the county to teach

 - Registration for attending classes is open from Oct 3-12
 - Classes will be for 4 weeks and take place on Wednesdays from 3:15-4:45pm
 - Dimissal at 4:45 will be carline, rather than parents picking up in the building
- Outdoor Movie Night
 - First outdoor movie night in October need a chair or co-chair
 - PTO has a movie license and a large blow up screen, but we need someone to help us work out logistics for the event and will probably need night-of volunteers to help everything go smoothly
- Trunk or Treat
 - This will be during the school day again this year BUT for a longer chunk of time
 - Students will be able to dress up and visit the event outside
 - o Brandon and Jessica Meade co-chairs it
 - A lot of opportunity for volunteers here decorating trunks, running games, etc

Treasurer's Report by Jessica Whiteley

- Increased expenses and income 10% across the board to account for additional student count
- Closed last school year with around \$16,128.14
 - Still need to pay approx. \$5,000 for whiteboard tables from last year

- \$5,000 required rollover
- Approx. \$6,500 remaining as additional carryover income before fundraising this year
- Spirit Night Flavors Wadder Ice brought in \$214!
- Gator Gear sales/profits will come at the next meeting

Budget Amendment Proposal for Schoolwide Project

- GES was awarded one of the Stafford Education Foundation's historic mural projects
 - To be completed on the wall behind the garden by our playgrounds
 - All students will get a chance to help paint!
 - Starting in September
 - Ties in early Garrisonville area history along with Gwenyth's Law
 - Garrison brothers were original postmasters of Stafford County
 - A state law was created based on the unfortunate passing of a former Gator and AGW Tiger while here at school
 - Promotes the importance of learning CPR
- Cost
 - Entire grant to cost approx \$14,000
 - The grant the school received is for \$4,000
 - Gwenyth's Foundation will be donating \$5,000 and we'd like to propose tonight that PTO make a donation
- Proposal
 - Amend the PTO budget to allocated \$5,000 carryover income to donate towards the mural project.
 - Vote will be by email this week
 - Email will outline the details of the mural project and the proposal

Principal's Report by Ms. White

- School year off to a strong start!
 - o Ms. White 10th year at GES, Mrs. Odlum's 8.5/9th
 - Transition day went well
 - Grateful to be at full capacity lots of new families and new teachers
 - 7 new grade level classrooms added this year
