## Pledge of Allegiance

## Treasurer's Report by Jessica Whiteley

- Taxes
  - o Completed and will be mailed tomorrow
- Mural Contribution
  - Vote passed last month to contribute \$5,000 of PTO funds to the GES historic mural project
    - \*\*Note: The funds (\$5,000 for the Mural show up twice in the budget – it is because the Gwyneth's Gift Foundation wrote their donation check to the PTO instead of the school
      - The money was deposited into the PTO account and then distributed appropriately to the school per Gwyenth's Gift's intention.)
- Boosterthon Money
  - o \$28,271 profit this year, which far exceeds our goal!
    - Income 60,541.90
    - Percentage 27,066.51
    - Amount made 33,475.39
    - Other expenses (shirts and setup) 5,204.34
    - Total amount made 28,271.05
    - Budget 19,000
- Gator Gear
  - o We continue to be over our expected income in this area, which is AWESOME!!

- \$6,636 has come in for orders so far this year (which amounts to \$2,343 profit/fundraised, with an annual profit goal of \$500. So about \$1,800 over our fundraising goal!
  - Income 6,636.91
  - Expense 4,293.78
  - Amount made 2,343.13
  - Budget 500

## Membership

- o We would like to continue to encourage those who are not members to join PTO!! We have a projected income of \$1,650 in this area and so far we are at about \$1,227.
- o Income 1,227.98
- o Budget 1,500
- Boosterthon Teacher Incentive
  - We made significantly more than budgeted for Boosterthon, and the grade-level incentives reflect a percentage of what each grade-level brought in during the fundraiser
    - Numbers were adjusted to account for the increase and will be distributed as follows
      - Kindergarten \$768
      - 1<sup>st</sup> Grade \$862
      - 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade \$1,188
      - 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade \$1,147
      - 4<sup>th</sup> Grade \$1,213
      - 5<sup>th</sup> Grade \$933
      - Total \$6.111
- Five Guys Spirit Night
  - We had our BEST SPIRIT NIGHT YET last month at FIVE GUYS
    - As a school we raised \$1,283.04!

#### **Updates**

- Boosterthon
  - o 72% of students participated 56% had donation pledges
    - We exceeded our fundraising goal, which is AMAZING!!
  - o 26 eligible corporate matches
    - Have been contacted
  - o We have signed contract for next Fall (Aug 22-31, 2023)
    - The incoming PTO board for next year would still have an opportunity to opt-out if that was a desire
- Membership
  - o We are still under our anticipated annual financial goal in this area and would like to continue to increase membership!

- There are 161 total members so far (4 remain unpaid), 26 members added since the last meeting.
- o Working on directory for those who opted-in
  - Hoping to be completed in the next couple of weeks and will be accessible online
- Gator Gear
  - o We had 126 orders from our online sale last month
    - Only 10 back ordered items, but they will be here this week
  - o We are looking to potentially place another order some time in January, so the items will be in by Gator Week
- Spirit Nights
  - o 144 students/staff signed in at the FIVE GUYS Spirit Night!!
    - \$200 in the past was considered a 'good amount' to raise \$1,200 is above and beyond amazing!
    - Mrs. Kuzma's class won and will vote on their prize
  - o The NEXT spirit night is on October 19<sup>th</sup> from 4-8pm at Chipotle
    - This one you must say you are with Garrisonville or show our flyer when you checkout!
  - o Some food trucks attending our outdoor movie night have expressed interest in giving a percentage of sales back to our school, as well.

#### **After School Enrichment**

- Fall/Spring after-school program with activities
- Registration for attending classes is open from Oct 3-12
  - o Classes are for 4 weeks and take place on Wednesdays from 3:15pm-4:45pm
  - o Dismissal is at 4:45pm and will be through carline, rather than parents picking up in the building
  - o Flier sent home with details about how to sign up
    - First-come, first-serve
    - Registration form will open on Tuesday (10/4) night at 6:30PM

- Friday, October 14, 2022 6:45pm
  - o Movie begins at 7:15pm Hotel Transylvania Transformania
    - AG Wright is having a dance until 6pm, so we pushed back the time 15 minutes to give the parking lot a chance to clear out before our arrivals
  - o Location AG Wright's Blacktop
    - Food trucks will drive up the curb and around to the backside of the school so they're easily accessible while the movie is playing

- Monday, October 31 During the school day again this year
  - o Will allow for a longer chunk of time for students compared to last year
  - o Students will be able to dress up and visit the event outside
  - o Costume Donations
    - We are accepting costume donations until Friday, October 28<sup>th</sup>
    - There will be a costume box for donations available at movie night on Oct 14 and also in the GES main office
  - o Volunteers
    - Trunk Sign-ups
      - There are 9 trunks currently signed up. We'd like more!
    - Still a lot of opportunity for volunteers here decorating trunks, running games and stations, etc

    - Currently results are about 50/50, however many staff have not taken it yet.
    - Will be resent in order to gauge interest
- Needs
  - o Volunteers are needed in MANY capacities!
    - Looking for people to "head" different areas of the event
    - Many "pre-work" volunteers are needed to help prep/create/make different things for the event
    - High need for volunteers to help on the day of the event as well
      - Signups for day-of shifts will come at a later time

# Principal's Report by Ms. White

- No school for students on Friday 10/7
  - o It is a teacher workday, which will be used to finalize 1st Quarter Report Cards.
- No school for students on Monday 10/10
  - o Parent/Teacher conferences will be taking place
  - o Teachers will review first quarter report cards and assessment benchmark data with parents.
- Field Trips
  - o We had our first official field trip request
    - 125 5th grade students will go to the Science Museum in Richmond

• Just to provide an idea if the costs to do these trips: \$6,300 is required for 3 charter buses (charter buses must be used when traveling over a certain mileage \$1,200 per bus x 3.) Admission to museum totals around \$2,400!

# Staff Presentation by Ms. Golles — Library, Literacy Programs & the Maker Space

- o The library was renovated about 6 years ago. The most recent addition is a 3-D printer, which there are plans to utilize the printer to target specific SOLs meaningfully.
- Student Book Checkouts by Grade Level
  - o Kindergarten 1 book
  - o 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> Grade 2 books
  - o 3rd, 4th and 5th Grade 3 books

## **Emerging Requests**

- o Library Ms. Golles
  - o Planning to add a "Story Walk" in the garden area outside
    - Costs approx. \$6,100
      - There have been 2 after school "Movie Nights" to fundraise for the story walk.
      - Asking through emerging requests for assistance from the PTO to cover the final \$2,000 for the Story walk
      - Also seeking assistance from volunteers to help dig about 20 post holes.
- o 1st Grade Teacher Team (Presented by Mrs. Sonnenberg)
  - o Requesting 5 White Board tables
    - More compact and will take up less room
    - Able to fit more students comfortably
    - Why you should approve:
      - Grade-level conformity (equal access to supplies and resources for all 1st grade students)
      - Long-term (durable and long lasting)
      - Student needs (Elevates small group instruction)
      - Willing to apply our 1st grade Boosterthon Incentive funds (\$850).
      - Requesting \$955 from PTO for remainder to fund the tables
- o Both emerging requests will be sent out for a blind email vote of members
  - o Please reply Yes or No to fund each item once the email is distributed

#### **Open Comments/Input**

- Yearbook
  - o Clarification of the Yearbook line item on budget (previous year vs this year?)
  - o Discussion of Yearbook Payment & Ordering Timeline

- Promote digital payment and accommodate cash if requested
- When should ordering open?
  - Discussion of potential timeframes, ultimately decided to wait until January
- Any way to get yearbooks earlier?
  - Working towards that balance between having them before school is out and making sure that a majority of "events" are included in the yearbook
- Cost
  - There will be more pages because of more students, but would still like to keep the price \$20 /yearbook, if feasible.
- Lifetouch picture retakes are scheduled for November 2, 2022
- Reptile World
  - o Deposit has been paid for Gator Week show
    - Will do 2 or 3 shows depending on capacity in Gator Dome
- Discussion of fundraising opportunities vs decision to keep events "free entry" etc.
  - We are trying to have events as "Community Events" trying to minimize overhead costs for families (to be able to participate), but provide opportunities to pay for part of events (ex: costs for extra cards at Bingo, Silent Auction, Vendors at Holiday Festival)
  - o Bingo (new VA state laws are in place, so we are researching how this will impact our Bingo event).
    - For example a certified caller is required, there is a restriction of prizes, and cards have to be purchased by certain VA retailers to name a few. More information forthcoming!
- Question (regarding the vote re: Mural) did it pass?
  - o Yes response (47 'Yes'; 2 'No')
