Emerging Requests

Proposal given by Mrs. White

- Request for 8'x12' classroom carpets for grades K-3
 - Used for students for instructional purposes throughout the day
 - Currently 4 classrooms per grade level for a total of 16 carpets
 - Next year, 5 classrooms per grade level for a total of 20 carpets
- Request for kidney-shaped dry erase tables for grades 4-5
 - Used for students for instructional purposes throughout the day
 - 6' long kidney-shaped table for small group instruction
 - Currently 4 classrooms per grade level, for a total of 8
 - Next year, 6 classrooms per grade level, for a total of 12
- Cost Approx \$10,600 for all classrooms

Funding Sources

- Remaining school Boosterthon funds (approx. \$5,500)
- Emerging request funds (approx \$5,000)
- Any excess would be taken out of school's grade-level incentive Boosterthon funds from 2022-23 school year
 - Would need to purchase soon to guarantee arrival for start of the school year in the Fall

Budget Question

- What/where does money exist to pay for items?
 - \$21,070.93 will be in the account after expenditures
 - The money is there to forward, if needed
 - \$5,000 that we set aside for emerging requests every year has not been used
