Treasurer's Report by Jessica Whiteley

- Membership hit our budgeted number \$1,500
- Boosterthon numbers are not in yet hope to have those in the next week
- The budget will change to account for no income from Trunk or Treat this year

Trunk or Treat

- October 29th with rain date, November 5th
- COVID mitigation
 - All mitigation protocols must be implemented and followed to the fullest extent
 - Anticipating that this will be a highly attended event there isn't a way to do it traditionally and have it remain safe and in compliance
- Alternative Option
 - Activity that will occur during the school day
 - There will be a sign-up forthcoming to decorate trunks and come to the school during a designated time slot and park in the car rider lot
 - There will be guidelines for the decorations
 - Students will come to school dressed-up and have the opportunity to walk around with their parent during a 15-20 minute scheduled time slot (parents and younger siblings MUST sign in at the main office and MUST follow all health/safety mitigation protocols, including wearing a mask at all times while on school property)
 - All students will get a pre-packaged "goodie bag" to take home. Students will vote on their favorite trunk
 - There will be many more details to come regarding the event, but a huge positive is that ALL students will get to participate! Mrs. White will insure that scheduling has the least educational impact on student learning!

 - GES Staff and students are working hard to insure all are following all health/safety mitigation strategies
 - Daily functioning is back to where it used to be in regard to student learning
 - If a potential exposure occurs, the nurse will contact you and explain the quarantine procedures, etc.
 - There have been a couple of handfuls of situations where quarantining is necessary (under 40 staff/students). These cases have resulted from community contact/potential spread situations.
 - The areas of highest potential are on the bus and in special needs rooms where physical distancing is not as easily achieved/maintained.

 - o October 8th marks the end of the 1st quarter
 - o October 11th is a teacher workday, no school for students
 - Teachers will be reaching out to parents to set up parent/teacher conferences to review 1st Quarter data (as well as testing data).
