 - Immediate profit will be approximately \$630
 - Ordered 64 extra t-shirts to bump us up to the next price point with the screen printing cost, so have the potential to make additional \$800+ once those are sold
- *Hoping* to have the product back from the screen printer this week to be distributed in classrooms next week

 - Finalizing prices for the food

- Chick-fil-a gave us a 15% discount on 100 chicken biscuits cost \$230
