## **Treasurer's Report by Jessica Whiteley**

- Balance as of 10/28/2021 \$31,163.81
- Taxes
  - Completed and will be mailed this week
- Fall Fun Friday (aka Harvest Night/Trunk or Treat)
  - Spent about \$300
    - Well under budget
  - We were budgeted to profit \$1,100 if we had held the regular, paid-entry event
- Boosterthon Money
  - Starting to spend the money that we give to the school (usually \$10,000) on equipment for indoor and outdoor recess
    - Spent \$2,923.49 on indoor games, 2 large recess storage bins, outdoor balls, frisbees, games and a variety of other equipment
    - Will be spending on an as-needed basis due to uncertainty of budget
- Panda Express Spirit Night
  - Brought in \$133.88
- Overall
  - Unclear if we will be able to profit on future events
  - We are being really careful to stay under budget on all expenditures until we can start earning money on events again.

## Inventory

- Stock is changing on a regular basis, but printer was more confident about being able to get the products we need
- We do not plan on ordering extras to keep on hand so as of right now, this will be the only opportunity to get spirit wear this year
- Designs from previous years
  - Some designs we currently have in stock very limited size and color options
  - We will not be placing custom orders for those designs what we have listed is all we have
  - Any orders that include only these currently in-stock items may be delivered early

## Delivery

- Anticipating about a 3 week turnaround from the time we get our bulk order to the printer
  - Gives us about a week of flexibility in getting them to students before winter break
  - Hopeful items will be delivered to classrooms before winter break, but can't guarantee it at this time. Lots of factors that are out of our control with national supply chain issues.
  - Printer is close so we can pickup our order rather than having to wait for shipping, which will save us some valuable time
  - Updates on status will be posted to our website, social media and emailed as necessary
- All items will be delivered to your oldest child's classroom unless otherwise noted on your order
  - Text box on the website on each product page where you can tell us if you do not want your order sent to the classroom
  - We will contact those people individually to arrange for pickup

  - Purchasing books for teachers

    - Parents can choose one of those to purchase

  - Twinkle Shop
    - Gather donations, etc to provide gifts for needy families in the school community for the holidays
    - Ms. White says that the school covers this for our student body
      - Notification goes out to families to request need
        - Thanksgiving basket info is going out next week

- Names are run through the Dept of Social Services to make sure they aren't already receiving holiday support from them
- Family members (including siblings not at our school) submit wish lists, clothing/shoe sizes, etc
- Staff and other partnering organizations purchase wish list items as they would an angel tree, wrap the gifts, provide food baskets
